GP Extended Access

Fiona Pickering and Fiona Cleary have been working together with a Mid Cluster Alliance that includes East Dorset, Poole North, Poole Bay, Poole Central, Poole Hospital, SWAST, DHUFT and the two federations of Castleman Healthcare and Healthstone to develop a proposal that is primary care led.

This also includes supporting Poole Hospital to get GP Streaming up and running and working with DHUFT to ensure that future plans will include access from Wimborne and Swanage.

Emails have been sent from the The Mid-Dorset Alliance asking for GP sessions to be covered as well as a survey asking for input into what an extended primary care team supporting improved access could look like. Further communications will be sent to all practices about how they can book appointments in the next few days.

Workflow Optimisation at Canford Heath



Canford Heath Group Practice are piloting Workflow Optimisation training provided by Insight Solutions to a member of their team in November. If successfully rolled out at Canford Heath and if proved to save GP time and workload the Transformation Board will look to roll this out across East Dorset and Poole North next year. Over 75s



As we are sure you are aware the CCG are pushing for an "at scale" Over 75s service from 2019. Sue Richards has been working hard to draw together from each of our practices information about what we all do now to form a picture of what is currently available to our patients across East Dorset and Poole North.

We are aware of the sensitive nature of the CCG's push for practices to work together to deliver their Over 75s service and what it may mean for practices from 2019. We are also aware that many of our schemes are working well and practices don't wish to lose what they already have.

With this is mind Sue is formulating a plan to ensure practices retain the elements of their own Over 75s

services that are working well whilst drawing together other services to fulfil the CCG's ambition of "at scale" working.
